MSSD Medication Policy Agreement Form

According to the Medication Policy found in the Student Life section of the MSSD Parent-Student Handbook: Students are not permitted to keep medications of any kind in their dormitory rooms. All medications must be stored in the Student Health Service (SHS). Supplies of medications are dispensed as directed by the SHS. Parents/legal guardians and students are responsible for bringing the medications to SHS. This includes, but is not limited to:

- Prescription medications
- Over the counter medications, (ibuprofen (Advil), acetaminophen (Tylenol), ect.)
- Vitamins, supplements or herbal medications
- This policy does not apply to Inhalers or Epi-Pens

Any exceptions to this policy must be pre-approved by the Student Health Services (SHS) medical staff in advance. Students who are found storing, taking or distributing medications from their dorm without SHS approval will be subject to disciplinary actions which can include written warning, suspension, or expulsion.
