In this historical moment, we will never forget the journey that occurred in 2020-2021. This year has impacted so many of us. We have learned how to adapt and deal with many circumstances throughout this arduous journey. We have faced hatred and insanity and searched for ways to become better and more hopeful.



These days, people have their own lives and their daily routines. But as the coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic spread around the world during 2020-2021, businesses, schools, sports, concerts, and many other events were closed, canceled, postponed, or went remote. Everyone did their best to adapt to quarantining; even so, they missed their families and friends. Everyone changed their lives to focus on technology. Meanwhile, healthcare workers, doctors, and scientists battled to stop the COVID-19 pandemic. Many people passed away from COVID-19. Still, we have persisted, remaining together.



Also, the Asian American and Pacific Islander community has been facing the challenge of racism and increased violent acts during the pandemic. Xenophobia and discrimination have grown against this community. On March 19, 2020, Stop AAPI Hate was founded. Many people gathered together in various locations to protest anti-Asian hate and violence, staying strong and positive in their efforts. (On May 20, 2021, President Biden signed into law the COVID-19 Hate Crimes Act.)



On May 25, 2020, a teenager recorded a video of police brutality on a black man named George Floyd. She posted it on social media, where it went viral. This video made an impact around the world. The Black community was extremely angry and upset when they saw the video and so were many other people. The Black community members and those that supported them joined together in world-wide "Black Lives Matter" protests against racial injustice and inequality and to demand justice and equity.



On August 11, 2020, Democratic presidential candidate Joe Biden chose Kamala Harris as his running mate for vice president. This was historic as she was the first Black woman and South Asian American in that role. They won the election on November 7, 2020, and are now President Biden and Vice President Harris.

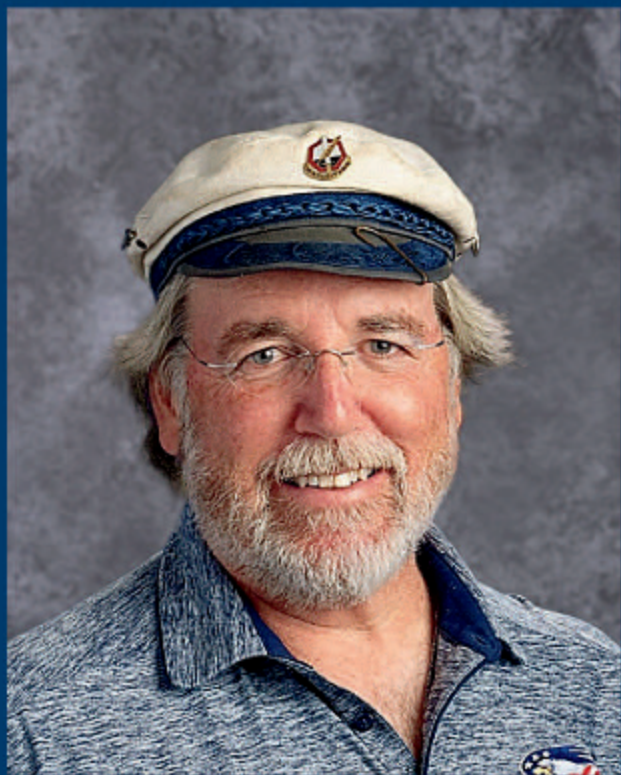

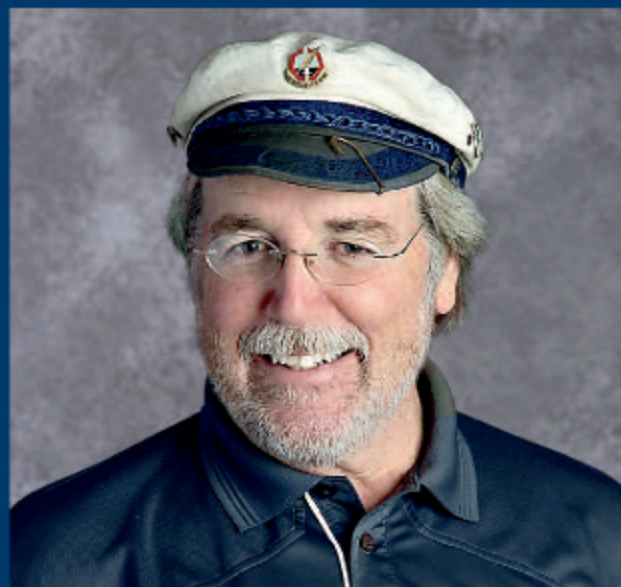




# Steven Doleac
